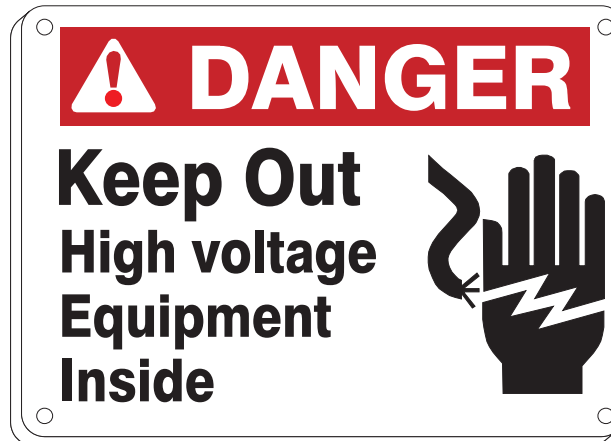
The biggest question we receive is “Should I use an ANSI or OSHA sign?”. The answer is as follows:

The ANSI signal head is preferred.

The header is a rectangle and includes an exclamation point. It usually includes pictogram that describes the action to be taken.

The wording uses both capital and lower case letters.

This is ANSI’s revision in 2002 (ANSI Z535.1 to 535.5).



The older OSHA standard is an “alternative only”

The header is uses an oval.
